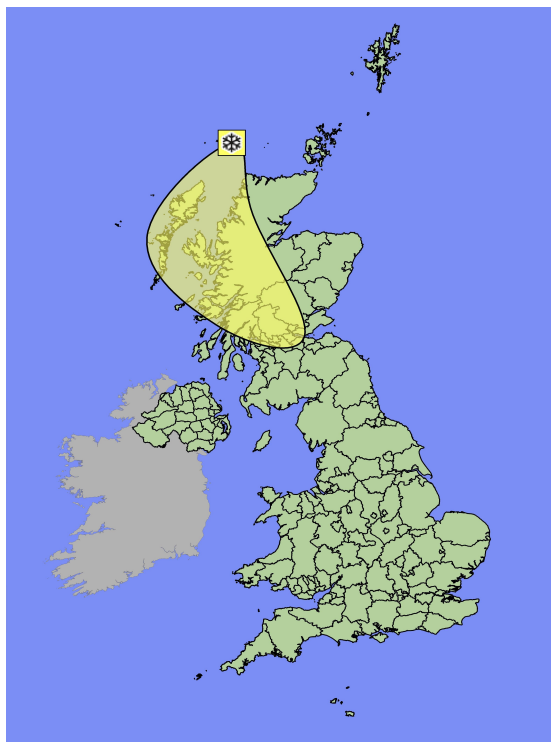




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Precipitation will fall as rain and sleet on coasts but readily turn to snow inland. There is currently a lot of variation amongst the computer models in their predictions for the extent of snow, and so confidence is not high in this warning.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert** of **Snow**

Valid from **00:00 on Sat, 10th Dec 2011** until **12:00 on Sat, 10th Dec 2011**

An area of sleet and snow is expected to move southeastwards across Scotland, and has the potential to leave a covering of 2-4 cm in places. There is currently more than average uncertainty in the timing and extent of snow, and this warning is likely to be updated.
