Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Strong northwesterly winds will affect many areas, with severe gales possible around the southwest coast of Scotland. Winds will ease overnight, before increasing again towards dawn. Showers will affect the north and west of the UK, with eastern areas largely dry. Persistent rain sweeps in from the west by the end of tonight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be extremely windy in Scotland, with damaging storm force winds likely, and very windy everywhere else. Rain will affect many places, with snow for Highland Scotland. Less windy on Friday but with snow showers in the north and west. Feeling cold with widespread overnight frost.
