

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Monday 19 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Sunny spells and scattered sharp showers in Scotland and Northern Ireland.  
Elsewhere, heavy rain across parts of Wales and northern and western England,  
with a risk of thunderstorms. Central and southeast England again staying warm  
and mainly dry with some sunshine.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Heavy or thundery rain in parts of central and eastern England at first,  
clearing by Wednesday afternoon. Otherwise, sunshine and showers, the showers  
turning locally heavy in northern and western areas, again with a risk of  
thunder. On Thursday, showers will become mainly confined to southern England by  
the end of the day, with northern areas becoming largely dry.
