Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A largely dry and bright day with lengthy spells of winter sunshine. However, wintry showers will affect the east coast at times, and perhaps a few showers for western Wales and southwest England during the morning. Feeling cold despite the sunshine.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
A band of patchy rain will cross the UK on Sunday, clearing Northern Ireland and Scotland by dawn, then pushing across England and Wales during the day. Milder air will follow the rain. Then turning colder on Monday, with gales in the north, and blustery showers, which will be heaviest and most frequent in the north and west.
