

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 09 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreak of rain will clear eastwards during the morning to leave a dry and bright day. However it will be feeling colder, especially in the breeze. Scattered showers will also continue in the west, with snow possible over northern hills. Overnight, most places will be dry and clear with colder temperatures bringing the risk of frost.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

After a cold start on Friday, cloud will increase from the west, with outbreaks of rain pushing east through the day, before clearing overnight. Saturday will then be largely dry and sunny but feeling cold, and with scattered wintry showers in the north.
