Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Showers in the north on Sunday will be wintry in places, mainly over hills,
along with brisk westerly winds. Cloud and rain will spread north and east to
Wales and many southern parts of England in the evening after a generally dry,
bright day.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain in the southeast of England clearing early Monday to leave most parts
bright with some sunshine. There will also be wintry showers in the west, these
becoming more widespread through the day. Generally much colder. Further sleet
or snow showers in the far north and east early Tuesday, otherwise dry with some
sunshine but cold.
