

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of locally heavy rain across western Scotland and Northern Ireland will spread southeastwards to northwest England and northwest Wales. Elsewhere it will continue mainly dry with sunny spells and feeling pleasant especially in the southeast. Northern Scotland and Northern Ireland will become mainly dry and brighter through the afternoon.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday outbreaks of rain across Wales and northern England will gradually spread southwards and become more patchy. The Southeast of England will be warm and bright. Brighter, but cooler with scattered showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Many places dry and bright on Tuesday, but scattered showers in Scotland.
