Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers will soon become widespread again, frequently heavy and occasionally accompanied by thunder. Fewer showers are expected in Scotland and more persistent rain is likely for Northern Ireland. It will become increasingly windy across the south. Feeling rather cool for July.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Little overall change is expected for Wednesday, with further heavy and locally thundery showers, particularly in the west, though these should ease in the south later. Thursday will start drier and brighter in most places, but rain and strong winds will spread from the southwest in the afternoon and evening.
