Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
There will be bright or sunny intervals today, with showers, these heavy and occasionally thundery, especially in the north and east. In the far northeast there will be rain which will continue overnight, whilst further rain is expected in to push into southern UK by dawn on Wednesday.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

The rain in the south will become more widespread through Wednesday, affecting much of England and Wales, then pushing north into Scotland later. Northern Ireland should see drier and brighter conditions. Rain in the far northeast will gradually ease through Thursday, whilst elsewhere it should be generally bright with a few showers.
