for the period 0000 UTC Sunday 05 June to 0000 UTC Monday 06 June 2022

General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. Further south various lows and associated fronts will bring much more unsettled conditions, with thundery showers or longer spells of rain expected in many areas, these very heavy in places.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 to 5 later, then veering east or southeast later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, backing northeast 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later near aberdeenshire.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast backing east or northeast, 2 to 4, but increasing 5 for a time in Firth of Forth.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less at first in north, otherwise northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4 backing northeast 3 or 4.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain or showers later in south.

Good, occasionally moderate later in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast backing north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Moderate.

Rain or showers, becoming fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in north, increasing 6 at times in south, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate.

Fair then rain, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming northerly or northwesterly, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 later

in south.
Moderate, becoming slight in south.
Rain or showers, becoming mainly fair later.
Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then becoming westerly or southwesterly later.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair at first in north, otherwise rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 to 6 becoming cyclonic 2 to 4, then southwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth for a time in west.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, backing southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming cyclonic 2 or 3, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, backing south or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first in east, becoming southwesterly 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time in lyme bay.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later in lyme bay.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6 at first in north, otherwise cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming southwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in east.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate near Cornwall and smooth in east.
Showers.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4 later except in far north.
Slight or moderate near northern Anglesey, smooth or slight elsewhere.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5 at first in far north, otherwise cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Moderate at first near northern Anglesey, otherwise smooth or slight.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in Solway Firth.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Fair until later in north, otherwise rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 to 5 becoming variable 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.
Rain then fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time later.
Slight or moderate.
Fair then rain or showers.
Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.
Rain then fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
East 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 at times.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in southeast.
Rain later in southeast.
Good, occasionally moderate later in southeast.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 2 to 4 becoming east 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Smooth or slight.
Rain at first in southeast, otherwise mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first in southeast.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5 becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first in far south, otherwise fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, but mainly east at first, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, increasing 5 at times later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north, becoming variable 3 or less for a time in south.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time later in far north.

Fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in south.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north, becoming variable 3 or less for a time in south.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 05 Jun 2022 at 0000 UTC until Sunday 05 Jun 2022 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Anticyclone remains slow moving over the Northern North Sea, while a weak Atlantic front will approach the north of Shetland Waters for a time.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

West becoming variable, 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 to 5, locally variable 1 to 3, becoming west or southwest by dawn.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell.

Isolated showers, risk locally heavy with thunder, also mist and a risk of fog patches, clearing during the morning.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor, perhaps very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Rain and drizzle, locally heavy, with mist and a risk of fog after dawn.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, perhaps locally very poor.
