Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of showery rain over northwest Scotland moving southeast and dying out. Showers across western parts of England and Wales will largely die out in the morning, then most places should see plenty of sunshine along with decreasing winds. Further cloud spreading across western districts in the afternoon.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Strong, locally gale force, southwesterly winds are expected, driving frequently heavy showers on to western coasts and well inland. Winds turning northwesterly on Friday. Some showers are likely to be of hail and may be accompanied by thunder. Eastern districts drier and sunnier. Feeling noticeably colder.
