

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across northern England and north Wales will move south through today with some moderate bursts, moving over the southeast tonight, clearing around dawn. Dry, bright and chilly to the south of that rain. Cool and breezy conditions with sunshine and some showers follow southwards, with dry, clear and chilly conditions overnight, and frost inland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Plenty of dry, sunny conditions, especially inland on both days. There will be some blustery showers in the west and also down the east coast, perhaps with some hail at times. Those showers will be wintry on hills and it will be rather cold generally.
