Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry with sunny spells for most today. However, the south-east and Wales will be affected by showers in the morning. Further showers, occasionally heavy, will develop later, mainly around the central spine of the country and the south-east. Showers will ease off after dusk, leaving a dry, cool night with clear spells.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday should be a drier day than today with plenty of sunny spells, although the south-west and Wales may see one or two isolated showers in the afternoon. On Wednesday cloudier conditions are expected as well as outbreaks of light rain, mainly in the north of the UK.
