Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Another bitterly cold day with a widespread frost and freezing fog patches which will clear most parts by lunchtime. Northern Scotland and Northern Ireland will see wintry flurries throughout the day and there will be further light snow during the morning across northern England and north Wales. Otherwise, much of the UK will be dry, with bright or sunny spells.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be predominantly dry, with sunshine across much of the UK. Wintry showers will affect northern Scotland, the northeast of England and Kent. It will become gradually milder during Thursday, with snow generally turning to rain in northern Scotland.
