Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A bright day in most places with spells of sunshine, although high cloud will make the sunshine rather hazy. Many parts should also be dry but a scattering of showers are likely for a time over parts of Scotland and northern England, and by this afternoon some locally heavy or thundery showers will occur across southern parts. Warm or very warm across the sunnier inland parts but cooler near to coasts as onshore breezes develop.

Showers across southern and eastern parts slowly moving away overnight with many places becoming dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Staying generally dry with sunny spells. Feeling warm.
