Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northwestern parts of the UK will see frequent, heavy showers blown in on a strong westerly wind, with further snow likely for the mountains of Scotland. Elsewhere it will be a largely fine day, with brisk westerly winds, although showers are possible in western parts and a few isolated outbreaks of rain are likely across southern England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Further rain is likely in the far south for a time on Sunday. Otherwise a mix of sunshine and blustery showers dominating. These showers are likely to turn to snow over higher ground, and increasingly to lower levels in the north on Monday.
