Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Heavy rain over many northern areas, with snow over high ground, will gradually move away later in the day. The heaviest rainfall will be across Northern Ireland, northern England and southern Scotland, with significant accumulations of snow expected over the north Pennines and southern Uplands.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Tuesday will be much drier and brighter for a time, with some ice in the east at first, before more rain spreads eastwards later. Rain is followed by sunshine and showers during Wednesday, but with wintry showers in the northwest. Winds strengthening, reaching gale force around exposed coasts.
