

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 10 Jan 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be generally wet and windy throughout with outbreaks of rain, turning to snow over northern hills, spreading eastwards. However, southeastern parts will remain dry until after dusk. This rain will be occasionally heavy, particularly across southern hills. Overnight, northern and western parts will become dry, with clear and icy spells developing, particularly across Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be generally dry with a good deal of sunshine and winds easing. Overnight southwesterly winds will increase and outbreaks of rain will once again spread from the west. However central parts will become dry, but cloudy, through Wednesday.
