Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early mist and fog will disperse this morning and then many areas will have a dry day with bright or sunny spells. However, persistent rain will spread across Northern Ireland and then into western Scotland during the afternoon. Rain lingering across western parts of Northern Ireland overnight, Scotland and western parts of the UK. Clear spells elsewhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday and Tuesday there will be rain at times across Scotland and western parts of the UK. Elsewhere mainly dry, although the odd isolated shower cannot be ruled out altogether. Patchy mist and fog will disperse to allow some sunshine through.
