Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain will only slowly clear the southeast of England. Elsewhere will see a mixture of bright spells and a scattering of blustery showers. The showers could be heavy for a time, particularly near western coasts. Turning a touch cooler with temperatures in most places falling slightly through the day.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Showers for many on Wednesday but these gradually clearing to the southeast then a drier and brighter to end the day. More rain and strong winds overnight and for a time on Thursday with a return to showers for Friday. Not quite as mild, and feeling chilly in the strong winds.
