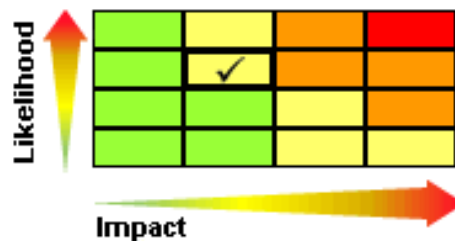
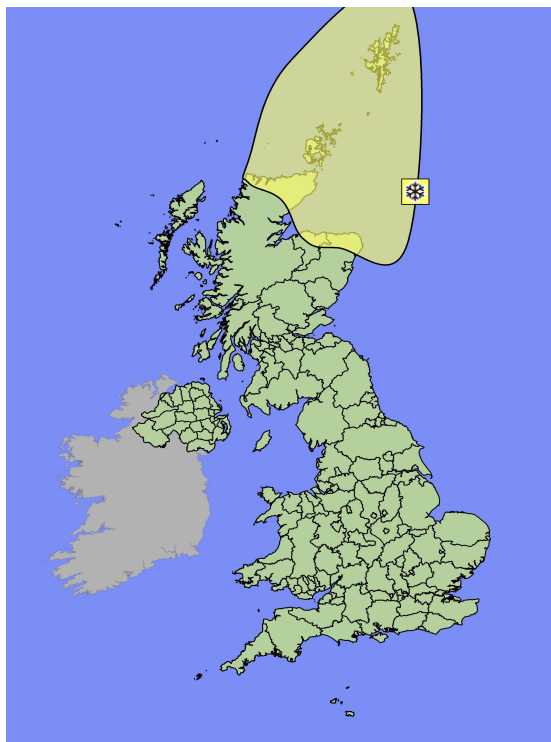




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Still some uncertainty regarding the track and timing of a polar air disturbance but certainly worth keeping up-to-date with forecasts for a potentially nasty mixture of strong winds and wintry precipitation.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Snow**

Valid from **00:00 on Tue, 06th Dec 2011** until **12:00 on Tue, 06th Dec 2011**

A period of sleet and snow accompanied by gale or severe gale force winds is likely to affect parts of northeast Scotland.

The public should be aware of possible disruption to travel.
