

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 05 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a largely dry, bright but cold start across the UK with icy patches in places. Through the morning, heavy rain and strengthening winds in southwest England will spread northeastwards, reaching all areas by evening with gales likely around exposed coasts. Winds will remain strong overnight but rain should turn more showery in nature with some clear spells.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Winds will remain strong on Monday with gales in places and sunny spells and showers, with the heaviest and most frequent showers across the west. Similar conditions will continue on Tuesday although winds will become somewhat lighter with fewer showers.
