

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 04 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain over Scotland will gradually ease and become mostly confined to the northwest. The strong winds also decreasing. For the remainder of the UK showers affecting western areas will generally die out with sunny spells for all parts before cloud and rain spreads from the west this afternoon and evening. The rain continuing for much of the night.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Sunny intervals and occasional showers after rain over Southeast England gradually clears on Tuesday. The showers heavy and blustery at first, becoming lighter and fewer during Wednesday. Mild for a time becoming colder later with the strong winds slowly decreasing.
