Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any mist patches will clear to leave another fine, dry and warm day for England and Wales. Scotland and Northern Ireland will be a little cloudier but mainly dry with only an isolated shower possible. It should stay dry and feel less cool for most overnight, but cloudier with the odd shower lingering across southern Scotland and northern England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will be a little cloudier for many throughout, but still with some pleasant spells of sunshine, the best of this across western parts of the UK. Winds will strengthen from the southeast by Friday, but temperatures will remain near normal.
