Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mostly rather cloudy today with showery rain, especially in the west.
Brightest in the east. Much of England and Wales will be windy. Gales
in exposed southern and western parts. Locally rather warm.
Largely cloudy and showery overnight, but becoming mainly dry over
southern and central England and south Wales.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Staying mainly cloudy with showery rain on Tuesday, sometimes heavy.
Becoming brighter and drier across Scotland and N.Ireland later. Some
fine weather, especially in the east in the morning on Wednesday, but
rain will spread across from the west. Generally windy. Temperatures
mostly near normal, turning rather cold in Scotland.
