

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early rain will clear eastwards, with brighter and drier conditions following for a time. Then a band of heavy rain and strengthening winds will move east across Northern Ireland to reach Wales, western Scotland and western England by this evening. Overnight the band of rain, and strong winds, will continue east across remaining areas of the UK, with showers following.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Saturday showers in the west initially, some heavy, also wintry across high ground from northern England northwards. Later rain will spread northeastwards across Wales and central England, expanding overnight to cover southern England, and will persist through Monday. Elsewhere showers.
