Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Much of the UK will be quite cloudy, with occasional rain or showers, more especially across Northern Ireland, western Scotland, west Wales and northwest England. Southwest England and south Wales should see some sunshine this afternoon though. Feeling fairly warm, especially in any brightness, with mainly light northwesterly winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain or showers for western Scotland and Northern Ireland on Monday, however dry with some sunny spells elsewhere. This rain will sink southeastwards on Tuesday to affect northern England and Wales, leaving scattered showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland, where also breezier. Bright and warm for southern England.
