

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 08 Mar 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain, becoming briefly heavy before blustery showers and clear spells spread to western parts during the afternoon and evening, with the rain clearing to the southeast overnight. Strong southwesterly winds developing from the west this morning, with gales in some exposed places, easing this evening.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Showers on Sunday, locally wintry to low levels with snow over higher ground, becoming heavy and squally in parts around the middle of the day. Rain and stronger winds spreading into the west after dark. Rain becoming widespread and heavy on Monday followed by showers, with some very strong and potentially damaging winds.
