Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Many places dry and sunny after a widespread frost, moderate in places. Overnight rain, sleet and snow across central-southern England soon clearing away. A few wintry showers near the east coast of England and far northeast Scotland. Scattered showers developing over East Anglia and southeast England during the afternoon. Cloud, rain and strong winds spreading into northwestern Britain by the evening, extending southeastwards across all but the far south of England by dawn. Temperatures near average to rather cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain over all areas on Tuesday clearing southeastwards followed by sunshine and showers. Further rain into the northwest later on Wednesday.
