

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain will become persistent across much of southern Britain, although it may become brighter for a time the far south. It will also become windy, with coastal gales likely along southern coastlines. Elsewhere, it will stay generally bright, although there will also be scattered showers, especially in the west.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloud and rain across the south will gradually clear eastwards during Thursday, with brighter weather following. However showers will continue to move in, especially to northwestern parts, and could be heavy and thundery at times. These then continue into Friday, perhaps also turning wintry over some northern hills.
