Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry, warm and sunny for most, but cloudier with occasional light rain across parts of northwest Scotland. Early mist, fog and low cloud should gradually clear affected western areas, becoming mainly confined to the immediate coasts. A dry night with clear spells across the whole country, with some fog patches developing across northern parts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Another dry, warm and largely sunny day for Saturday, although rather more cloud across Scotland at first, with perhaps some mist affecting eastern coasts. A little cloudier with isolated showers spreading eastwards during Sunday, but most places getting away with a dry and bright day.
