

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across much of Scotland today, although northern areas should have a dry morning. Elsewhere, most places seeing a mixture of sunny spells and scattered heavy showers, with a risk of thunder. Occasional rain or showers continuing overnight, becoming heavy in northeast Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain in Scotland becoming mainly confined to the northwest. Otherwise, scattered heavy and blustery showers continuing, with some good spells of sunshine in between, but more persistent rain spreading across England and Wales on Thursday night. Very windy in southern England and Wales for a time, particularly English Channel coasts.
