Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be cloudy with showers or longer spells of rain. The showers will be occasionally heavy, perhaps with hail and thunder, though will begin to ease in the west from late afternoon. The westerly winds will strengthen over the south of England and Wales.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A dry start for many on Thursday with the chance of some sunshine, but rain and strong winds will spread from the southwest to most parts by evening. Blustery showers will follow on Friday, though Scotland is likely to have a wet morning. Showers will decrease in the afternoon.
