

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 10 Mar 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Severe gales with damaging gusts particularly along the south coast of England will temporarily ease today, though severe westerly-gales will return to south and southwestern parts later. Rain in many parts at first, with snow on northern hills for a time, but most places will turn more showery later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

The very unsettled conditions will continue with further spells of heavy and persistent rain, interspersed by more showery interludes with clear or sunny spells. It will remain generally windy with gales, occasionally severe gales, these mainly affecting western coasts and hills.
