General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will maintain settled conditions across most northern parts of the United Kingdom during Tuesday, although a weather front will spread some outbreaks of rain northwards across England and Wales.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 at first near Cape Wrath, otherwise variable 3 or 4, easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Variable becoming southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Moderate to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 5 or 6 later.
Slight, becoming smooth.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
South 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less.
Moderate or rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.
Fair.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later in north.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.
Rain or drizzle at times, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable in south at first, otherwise, east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering south 5 or 6 later.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later in north.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain or drizzle at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable in south at first, otherwise, east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering south 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 1200 UTC until Wednesday 04 Nov 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Various weak troughs move east over Shetland area until ridge of high pressure briefly builds towards early Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 4 or 5 veering northwesterly 3 or 4 in north and west then

becoming variable 3.
Moderate or rough becoming slight close to east Shetland.
Rain or drizzle, becoming fair in west.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 04 Nov until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 04 Nov:

Variable 3 becoming easterly 4, occasionally 5 in west.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.
Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly in south.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to south 3 to 4, locally 5 at first, veering southwest before dawn tomorrow.

Slight to moderate.

Isolated showers, perhaps locally heavy overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 2 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 after midnight.

Slight locally moderate, with a low swell.

Isolated showers, dying out overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in showers.

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
