

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a cold and bright start with a patchy frost and the risk of ice on untreated surfaces. Much of England and Wales will stay fine and cold with much lighter winds and some sunny spells, however across western Scotland and Northern Ireland it will turn wet and windy, which will continue overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Saturday will see mild, wet and windy weather spread southwards, giving some heavy and persistent rain on western upslopes. It will turn drier from the north later and this will spread southwards into Sunday morning, however further wind and rain will arrive in the north-west.
