

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Locally heavy rain across Scotland turning more showery through the day.
Elsewhere, sunny spells and scattered showers spreading eastwards, these sometimes heavy and thundery. Remaining breezy, and feeling rather cool in exposed parts. Further spells of rain across Scotland overnight, these spreading into northern England and Northern Ireland. Showers elsewhere largely dying out, with increasingly clearer spells developing.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Sunny spells for most on Wednesday and more in the way of drier weather, especially for Scotland. However there will be a few showers, these perhaps heavy at times. Thursday, sunshine and locally heavy and thundery showers, especially in south and east.
