Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Remaining rather cloudy, although there will be some brighter periods at times. Widespread outbreaks of rain or drizzle can be expected in most places, although this will generally be light in nature. Moderate easterly winds in most places, though strengthening in the north and west.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining unsettled with occasional outbreaks of rain in most places, but also some drier and brighter periods too. It will turn progressively colder across northeast Scotland on Friday with some snow over higher ground. During Saturday the risk of snow over higher ground will spread south with some snow to lower-levels across northeast Scotland later.
