

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 19 Aug 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A mostly fine and dry day with some sunshine, however a few showers will affect northeastern Scotland at first. Thicker cloud and rain will also move into northwestern parts later, before moving southwards to affect southwestern and central parts throughout the night. Elsewhere staying largely dry overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Sunshine and scattered showers across the north of the UK on Saturday, but further south will be rather cloudy with some outbreaks of rain, with just southeastern parts staying dry until dusk. Rather cloudy at first on Sunday with further rain, possibly heavy in the east, turning brighter though in the west later.
