Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A bitterly cold day with a raw easterly wind. Northeast England and Eastern Scotland will see some locally heavy accumulations of snow, while most other areas will see some snowfalls. It will be driest in parts of the west with brighter spells at times.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday: Snow will gradually ease in northeast Scotland. Dry for a time elsewhere, though rather grey with little in the way of brightness. Milder for most and rain, preceded by snow will move into the west later. Saturday: Sunshine and blustery showers for most, more frequent and heavy in the northwest.
