Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will have a generally dry day, although rain is likely for a time in the far southwest, whilst parts of Scotland will see outbreaks of rain and hill snow through the day and night. Much of the UK will stay dry overnight, with frost, some ice and patchy fog for England and Wales.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of showery rain in the northwest should gradually extend across the northern half of the UK through Wednesday. Elsewhere should remain dry, with the best of the sunshine in the southeast. Thursday should be breezy and cloudy with some rain or drizzle at times,.
