Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a chilly start, a band of heavy rain affecting western areas at dawn will push east across southern and central parts of England and Wales through the day, clearing the east by evening. Remaining areas will see sunny spells and showers, with the heaviest and most frequent showers across the west, and it will stay rather cold.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

After a cold start, much of Sunday will be sunny before turning wet and windy across western areas by evening. After a wet night, rain will clear the east by Monday afternoon. Sunny spells and showers will follow with winds remaining strong.
