



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

An intense low pressure system developing in the northern North Sea will feed a slow moving band of rain into Shetland today, this easing overnight. Rainfall totals of more than 50 mm are likely.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **12:00 on Sat, 09th Aug 2014** until **23:45 on Sat, 09th Aug 2014**

A spell of wet and windy weather will affect Shetland today. The public should be aware of the risk of standing water and difficult driving conditions.
