Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Much of England and southern Scotland will be dry and fine with sunny spells, the best of the sunshine expected this morning. Elsewhere, showers of sleet and snow will affect northern Scotland, with wintry showers across Northern Ireland and Wales. Also, a few wintry showers could occur across parts of England. Rather windy and feeling cold.

Wintry showers continuing over northern and some western areas overnight. Most places, however, will be dry with a widespread frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain, sleet and snow in the north and west on Sunday but mainly fine elsewhere. Rain affecting northern and, later, western parts on Monday.
