

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 10 Dec 2017

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Significant snowfall across parts of England and Wales giving large accumulations in places, but easing through the afternoon. Less cold with local gales and showers in the south, after early rain clears. Northern parts mainly dry, bright and cold. Snow turning patchier overnight, while moving south, clearer further north. Very cold with locally severe frost and isolated freezing fog patches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wet and windy in the south and southeast on Monday with some sleet or hill snow possible across southeastern parts. Elsewhere, cold and bright with wintry showers in the north. Mostly dry and bright with some coastal showers on Tuesday.
