

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 02 Dec 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Showery outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow spreading southeastwards across  
England, clearing Kent mid afternoon. Otherwise sunshine and scattered wintry  
showers, but southwest England becoming generally cloudy with rain. Feeling cold  
in brisk northwesterly winds. Tonight, rain spreading across southern areas,  
heavy in the southwest and perhaps turning to snow inland. Elsewhere, a  
widespread hard frost and patchy freezing fog.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain or sleet in the south clearing early Wednesday. Otherwise cold with some  
sunshine, but freezing fog may persist in places all day. Heavy rain and strong  
winds spreading east Thursday with the risk of heavy snow in the north.
