Headline:

Showers dying away then dry and clear for a time. Increasing cloud and wind will bring rain to western areas by morning.

Rain spreading east, some turning rather heavy, but drier, but still cloudy weather will spread eastwards to most places during the day. Becoming very mild.

Outlook for Sunday:

Rain clearing the southeast, then sunshine and squally showers. Severe gales in places.
