Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many eastern areas will become dry with sunny spells. Scattered showers will continue in central and western areas, and across Northern Scotland. Strong northwesterly winds with local gales in the south, and over the Scottish Highlands this morning. Feeling chilly. Tonight, many inland places dry with clear periods. Becoming frosty with lighter winds. Isolated showers possible over western coastal areas.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Further heavy rain will spread from the west on Saturday, this turning wintry over northern hills, then conditions will turn more showery later. Strong southerly winds, veering westerly later. Heavy showers with very strong winds in the south on Sunday.
