

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain over Northern Ireland are expected to reach the southwest of England and Wales by evening. Elsewhere, the day will start fine, sunny in many places, but showers will develop again. These will chiefly affect central and eastern England, where they are likely to be heavy and perhaps thundery. Much of Scotland will stay dry.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A few showers on Tuesday perhaps heavy in the east but many places staying dry with some sunshine at times. Generally dry on Wednesday with bright or sunny spells but western coasts and hills may become rather cloudy with a little rain.
