

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud across central and eastern parts of the UK will lift and break up to leave most places dry, warm and sunny. A few showers are likely to develop in Scotland but these should die away tonight. Low cloud will then spread from the east into many areas, leaving clear spells confined to far western parts of Britain by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday and Monday's weather looks similar, with cloud gradually thinning and breaking to allow sunny spells and just a few showers across northwestern parts of the country. However, it may turn cloudy and damp in the west on Monday evening.
